



## 2017 Pickens High School SR. Scholarship Opportunities

- **Bent Tree Foundation Scholarship**

**Be a graduating senior of Pickens County High School** entering an accredited two-year or four-year post-secondary degree program or a one-year certificate program.

**Complete the Bent Tree Foundation Scholarship application** found on line at benttreefoundation.org (September 6, 2016).

**Provide the Scholarship Committee a transcript of your high school grades including GPA.** (if not an official transcript, copy of official transcript will be sufficient). **Applicants should have a minimum GPA of 85.00.**

**Provide copies of official scores for SAT and/or ACT.**

**Provide two personal references (recommendations):** one from a teacher, one from an adult of your choice (employer, minister, personal friend, etc.).

**Provide a letter of acceptance from the school you plan to attend.** You must be entering an accredited two-year or four-year post-secondary degree program or a one year certificate program. If not available by the application deadline, it may be mailed to the Committee postmarked no later than April 15, 2017.

- **Big Canoe Chapel announces the availability of scholarship funds to selected high school seniors in the class of 2017.** The primary criterion for determining the amount of the scholarships is family financial need. The secondary criterion is scholastic achievement. Extracurricular activities are also taken into consideration.

**WHO MAY APPLY FOR A BIG CANOE CHAPEL SCHOLARSHIP?**

Any student may apply who: is a resident of Pickens or Dawson County, and is graduating from an accredited high school or homeschool program, and wishes to further his/her education as a full-time student in any college or vocational/technical school.

**TO BE CONSIDERED** for a Big Canoe Scholarship, students must do the following:

Complete a Big Canoe Chapel **Scholarship Application**. Provide the Scholarship Committee with an official transcript of high school grades. Applicants must meet the minimum **HOPE scholarship requirements**. Provide two written personal references: one from the school, such as a teacher, counselor, or administrator; and one from an adult outside the school or family. Complete the **Senior Profile**. A school counselor will provide the necessary information to secure and complete the form. The completed form must be type-written. Please be as specific as possible in responding to the questions. Provide a letter of acceptance from a college or vocational/technical school of choice. If not available by the application deadline, this may be mailed or faxed to the Chapel to be received no later than January 23, 2017. Also include your college ID number. (**DO NOT DELAY submitting scholarship application.**)

**The complete application must be in the counselor's office by NOON ON JANUARY 23, 2017.**
