- ✓ Attach a copy of your high school transcript
- ✓ Attach a current photo of yourself. This photo will not be returned.
- ✓ Attach three (3) written references from non-relative adults. Only one of these references can be from a teacher.
- ✓ Attach a letter of acceptance from the college or vocational/technical school that you plan to attend. If a letter is not available at the time of submission, it can be mailed after the deadline as follows:

 - What are your college goals, your work/career goals or plans after receiving your college degree?
 - Do you think it is important to work, either at a job or as a volunteer, during summer vacation? Make sure to explain your answer.
 - In what service activities, either through school, community organizations, church etc., have you participated?
- ✓ Attend the interview if you are selected as one of the 4 finalists for the scholarship.
