Carefully Read the following regulations:

- The cost of the permit for the 2023-2024 year will be as follows: Fee for Year **\$40.00** /2nd Sem Prorated ⇨
- Permits **must** be visible at all times. Replacement permits can be purchased for \$5.00.
- Students **must** have a current parking permit and park in the spot marked on it during school hours.
- Students must present a valid driver's license and insurance card at the time of purchase.**
- The driver of the vehicle is responsible for the behavior of his/her passengers.
- Once a student parks he/she will **immediately** leave the vehicle and enter the building.
- Students may not return to their vehicle until dismissal without administrative permission.
- All vehicles are subject to random searches at any time by the administration or designee. Students should always inspect vehicles before coming onto campus (before, during, or after regular school hours. Weapons or any other illegal objects, as defined by the Student Code of Conduct, that are found in the vehicle will be dealt with as being in possession on campus by the parking permit holder.**
- Buses and pedestrians have the right of way on campus. Drive carefully and responsibly. **Campus speed limit is** ⇨
- Tardy & Attendance consequences will be enforced as stated per the 2023-2024 Student Code of Conduct.**
9th-12th Unexcused tardies or absences = Loss of parking permit per tardy
13th-Unexcused tardies or absences = Suspension of driving privilege on PHS Campus for the remainder of the semester.
- Driving on campus is a privilege, not a right. A student's permit is subject to suspension/revocation by the administration at any time for non-compliance of the rules stated above as well as any board policies listed in the Student Code of Conduct.**
- Consequences for driving or parking on the PHS campus without a permit (Signs Posted):**
1st Offense - Warning, with an agreement that a permit must be purchased the next day. Subject to towing.
2nd Offense - \$10.00 Fine and an agreement that a permit must be purchased the next day. Fines paid will not go toward the purchase of a parking permit. Subject to towing.
3rd Offense - \$20.00 Fine and an agreement that a permit must be purchased the next day. Fines paid will not go toward the purchase of a parking permit. Subject to towing.
4th Offense - Vehicle will be towed at owner's expense. Student will not be allowed the opportunity to purchase a permit during that school year.
